

#### NORTHERN KENTUCKY CHILDREN'S ADVOCACY FACILITY (NKYCAC)

Each year, the United States receives three million reports of suspected child abuse or neglect. This implies that in Northern Kentucky, up to 25,000 children may be impacted by this heinous crime and require assistance from the Northern Kentucky Children's Advocacy Facility (NKYCAC), the region's sole center of its sort.
