Here's how it works:**

Since its inception in 2004, the Hunger Walk and 5K Run has raised more than \$2,000,000.00, the equivalent of 6,000,000 meals, for Freestore Foodbank community partners serving 20 counties in Greater Cincinnati, Northern Kentucky and Southeast Indiana. With each step you are taking you are directly impacting lives of those in our community. One step a time, one dollar at a time, together we can solve hunger.
