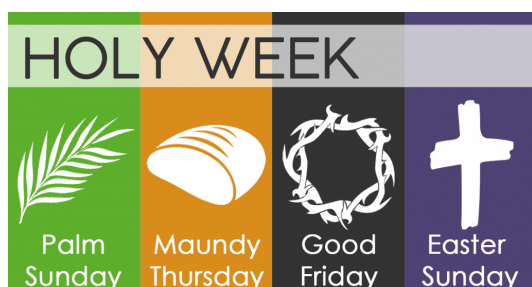
Easter OFFERING
