Farewell and Blessings on the Vanover Family

Dear members and friends of Immanuel,

We have an important announcement to make that is a call to prayer, and a testimony of God's faithfulness, even though it will be mixed with both sadness and gratitude. We have been blessed to have Matthew Vanover on our church staff as our Minister of Music for seven years. We have all enjoyed his musical gifts, leadership, and friendship. God has been faithful and generous to allow us to enjoy this season of ministry together. Matthew is now being led to go in a new direction and he will be leaving our church staff in the coming weeks.

For some time, Matthew has felt the need to move closer to family and aging parents (in Western Kentucky and Southern Indiana). He has also been feeling a need to try something new, perhaps beyond church-oriented employment. In the midst of that discernment process Matthew was approached to serve as the Executive Director of the Louisville Youth Orchestra. After careful deliberation he has officially accepted an offer to join their team and will begin on July 5th. Jessica has also accepted a position as a music teacher in Shelby County Kentucky. This will shorten the distance to their families by more than half. Matthew will continue to serve in a volunteer role and church participant for several more weeks.

In Matthew's own words, "If I could pick up this church and move it 100 miles or more west, I would likely never leave." Also, "I could never find another church job that wouldn't be a step down from Immanuel. The opportunity to lead this non-profit orchestra is an answer to prayer that I am excited about."

God has been faithful to the Vanover's in providing this new opportunity. Please pray for Matthew and Jessica, and particularly their young son Charles, during this transition, and for our church as well.

We will share more about this later, but God's faithfulness is also evident in the fact that Joanne Brumm, our former Minister of Music, is willing and able to serve as our Interim Minister of Music while we search for a new full-time staff member. Ellen Stephens (ISM – Strings Coordinator) has agreed to serve as Interim Director of our Immanuel School of Music. We believe that our music ministry will continue to prosper during this interim season, and we trust you to support these faithful servants as they provide leadership.

Once again, please keep the Vanover family, our church, and our music ministry in your prayers. We plan to have a reception and send off for Matthew and his family on **Sunday July 16**, in the Welcome Center (Lakeside Park) campus after each worship service. Please join us in sharing our love and gratitude for them and also in thanking the Lord for His ongoing faithfulness.

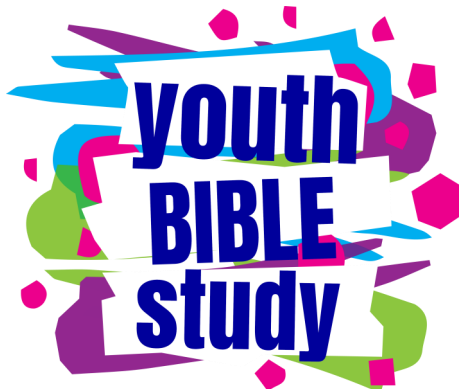
