WOMEN'S WALK TO EMMAUS #49 OCTOBER 19TH-22ND

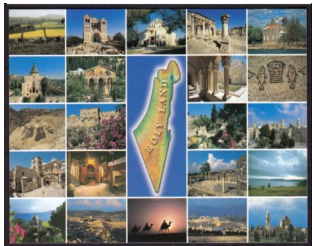

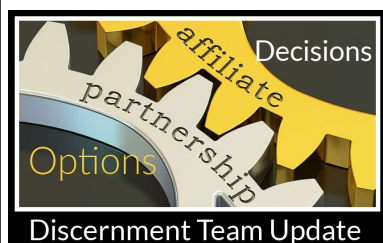


THE GLOBAL MISSION OF THE CHURCH
