Youth Valentine Spaghetti Dinner and Dessert Auction!

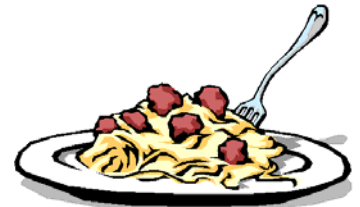

In 2009 our church will be engaged in a process of visioning. Every member and participant in our church needs to be involved in this process. What should we do as a first step? We should PRAY.

A vision is an image of a preferred future which motivates, orients, and compels people to move toward it. Without a shared vision, that is clearly stated and well communicated, any person or group (including a church) is most likely to stand still, get easily distracted or derailed, or drift into decline. A vision provides a landmark which we can use to constantly reorient our goals, priorities and strategies as we move toward that desired future. But who defines the "desired future"?

For churches the essential element is this - we must discern "God's vision." We must be motivated only by a desire to be and do and become what God desires for us. Human ambition, desires or ideas - apart from God - will never bear the fruit God wants for us. Therefore - the most important first step in any process of "visioning" is to pray.

One of the most common mistakes that churches make in "visioning" is that they do not involve the whole church in the process. The Pastor or a few lay leaders climb down from a mountain with stone tablets bearing a vision and then they try to "sell" that vision to a congregation. That may work sometimes - but only if the pastor and/or leaders have truly heard a calling from God and have seen "His vision." But why limit those listening and looking for God's revelation?

Leaders should lead - and they bear special responsibilities to decide and act - but they do not have exclusive access to hearing from God in prayer. Therefore the first and best way to involve the whole body of believers in the process is to ask them to pray.

God has a vision for our church and our community and it is our shared work to listen, discover, and follow that vision.

Will you begin now to pray? Pray for God to reveal His vision for our church. Pray for a clear sense of the future God desires for us, the values we need to embody on our journey, and the steps we need to take to continue moving toward God's vision.

Prayer is powerful. Vision is energizing. Combining the two enables the church to undergo a spiritual journey into the future God desires for us. Let's begin that journey.

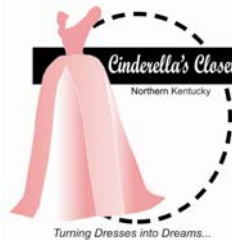

YOUR DONATIONS MADE A REAL DIFFERENCE IN MANY FAMILIES' HOLIDAYS!

As in the past, we delivered Christmas Dinner Baskets this past holiday season.

We served OVER 200 families! On Dec. 18th at Grace, about 125 boxes were handed out or delivered to people's homes. Each box contained dressing, potatoes, yams, vegetables, juice, cranberries, and candy. Immanuel's outpouring of food, cash and time donations was great. We shouldn't name names because we're going to miss a lot of people. But John Vince organized a great group of volunteers to meet at Grace on Dec. 17 and fill 100 boxes with food and drinks. Pastor Steve, Cheryl Sheets and Susan Eaton along with several others

were there for the distribution. Many others also donated time. Hams were then added to each box. The hams came from John Morrell Meats. We got a great price on them thanks to church member Bob Hall, who works there and has helped us each year. The demand that day exceeded the magic number of 100, but somehow we had enough extra food (fish and bread not included but it sounds like a familiar story). Some turkeys were found when we ran out of hams and the need that day was met.

On Dec. 20th, New Hope served 77 families, 310 mouths, and gave out 152 children's gift bags. There were 24 volunteers to make this happen. They also had refreshments and Christmas music while they were there. We had already given 60 hams to New Hope and they had to get more to meet the demand. Nancy Bay along with Jane Commins, Joni Burtner, and many other volunteers, do a great job every month of helping the families in the Southgate area.

The biggest thanks of all goes to the entire congregation. The contributions of food, along with several hundred dollars in cash donations, is what made this possible. **THANK YOU!!!!**

WORKOUT OPPORTUNITY AT IMMANUEL!

The Trustees have decided to make a new workout opportunity available for the Immanuel congregation. Now that we have your attention, one of Immanuel's great volunteers, Brad Burtner, has moved to Florida as many of you know. One of Brad's unsung ways of volunteering was to clear the sidewalks and steps at Immanuel. We have a gas-powered snowblower, shovels and a salt spreader. The parking lots are cleared by a commercial service, so essentially Immanuel needs you to provide service stewardship for an hour or two on Saturday/Sunday morning if there is snow.
