**Ash Wednesday** helps us remember two things: our need for saving grace; and our mortality - the fact that one day every person will die. To be preoccupied with death is morbid, but to take death seriously is a mark of wisdom. The important question is how we will live between our living of today and our dying of tomorrow. It is a choice of significant consequence and great value. There is a story about a young Jewish boy named Asher, who is walking down the street with his father when they come across a little dead bird on the sidewalk. Unable to look at it, Asher asks,

"Is it dead, Papa?" "Yes" I heard him say in a sad and distant way.

"Why did it die?"

"Everything that lives must die."

"Everything?" "Yes."

"You, too, Papa? And Mama?" "Yes."

"And me?" "Yes" he said,

"But may it only be after you have lived a long and good life, my Asher."

"Why must everything die?"

"That is the way it is since sin entered the world. It is the way God allows life to be."

"Why?"

***"So life would be precious, Asher."***

Most of us live as if life here on earth will last forever. Ash Wednesday sobers us to the truth that it will not last forever. It reminds us of the value of life and the importance of our choice to live it for God in service to others. It also begs the question - *in whom do we trust as we face the mystery of death?* It points to one amazing result of God's grace - it is the promise of resurrection from death for those who trust in Christ as savior and Lord.

The Lenten season is a time to reconnect with God and to recommit to live for Him. One suggestion: Make a greater effort to search the Scriptures - learn to listen and learn from the Word of God as a means to draw nearer to God.
