## Letter from the Senior Pastor

### *Falling in love with the Bible... but why should we?*

God has taken the initiative to reveal Himself in many ways - in history, in creation, through prophets, and most completely through the life, work, and teachings of Christ. In many circumstances these revelations of God are limited by time and place and are not accessible to all. To reveal Himself to all people something more was required - a WRITTEN RECORD.

To this end, God gave us the Bible. God chose to reveal Himself to us on the pages of this book. It is the written story of God pursuing a personal relationship with humanity. What makes this book so unique?

**First** of all it is different from any other book - in that it is the WORD OF GOD (not just a human word).

*"All scripture is GOD-BREATHED....none of it originated in the will of man...." (See 2 Tim. 2)*

The entire Bible makes this claim. There are thousands of examples in Scripture in which phrases such as *"Thus says the Lord"* or *"This is the word of the Lord"* are used. In John 10:35 Jesus said, *"For we know that the scripture is true forever."* Only something of divine origin could be true forever.

The Apostle Peter said, *"Above all, you must realize that no prophecy in Scripture ever came from the prophet's own understanding, or from human initiative. No, the prophets were moved by the Holy Spirit, and they spoke from God."* (2 Peter 1:20)

**Second**, the Bible is also unique in that, unlike any other book it is a book that is alive.

Hebrews 4:12 says, *"The word of God is living and active..."* When we read its words they reach out and connect with our lives in personal and tangible ways.

Isaiah 55:11 describes scripture as being a living agent or messenger that God sends to touch our lives.

*"... My word will not return to me empty, but it will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."*

**Third**, the Bible is also unique in that by reading its words a person can come to know God personally.

Romans 10:17 says, *"Faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the WORD OF GOD."*

John 20:31, *"...these words are written that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in Him."*

The Bible is God's written invitation to all of us. God invites us to adopt this book as our guidebook and our instruction manual for life. The words of Scripture are also a written invitation for to us to get to know God personally and to learn how to walk with Him daily. God has taken the initiative. Like all invitations this book calls for our response - how will you respond?

Approximately 10 National Honor Society students from Scott High School (coordinated by Ron, Missy and Emily Freking) packed and distributed almost 200 lunches on Sunday, February 15th. Sandwiches, Cheez-Its, grapes, potato chips, and cookies were repackaged from bulk into individual bags at the Immanuel kitchen. (Grace kitchens were in use by the Boys' Chrysalis).



The group also did other service projects in the interim between lunch packing and lunch distribution. These projects were leaf-raking, serious trash pick-up, and sign-board cleaning.

At 3:30 p.m. the crew set up on the Greenup Street sidewalk in front of Grace. Hot coffee and hot chocolate were offered as well as bottled water for beverages. Approximately 150 people came by for a meal. The youth volunteers rotated in and out of the cold.

Here's how the youth felt about their project: (from Missy Freking): Joe Phan said, *"Of all the service projects that I have helped with, this was one that I felt that I was really helping someone."* This statement was seconded by pretty much the entire group. An eye opener for most involved. They were all glad that they came out to help and they realize that not everyone lives in a nice warm house like they do. I think they left with a feeling of accomplishment. Even though the weather was cold, they all were upbeat and had a great time helping out, and would come back again to help.

Making sandwiches and bagging items up were the easy tasks. Seeing people that live out in the cold was the hard part for a lot of the kids that haven't been down there before. All in all the kids enjoyed getting to serve in Covington and feel like they have a better understanding of how the community really needed their help.

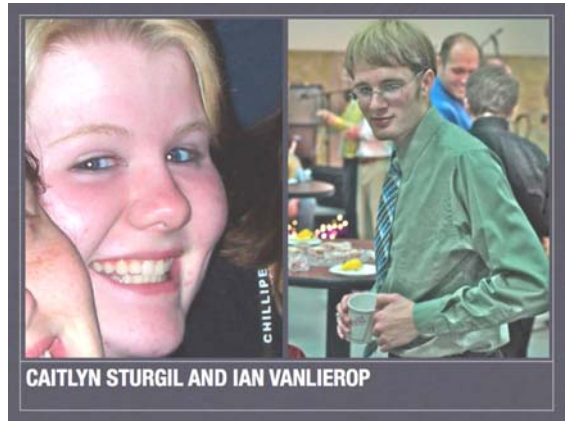

## Making an Impact...Chrysalis Makes an Impact on Immanuel Youth

On the weekends of January 17-19 and February 14-16, ten of Immanuel's youth participated in the girls' and boys' Chrysalis Flights that took place at Grace. Chrysalis is a weekend experience for youth 15-18 years old that allows them to get a glimpse of the unconditional, agape love of God. Chrysalis teaches youth what it means to be a follower of Christ in a fun, supportive, and encouraging atmosphere.

Caitlyn Sturgil, a member of our youth group and a junior at Newport Central Catholic High School said this about her Chrysalis experience:

### CARD MINISTRY SERVICE OPPORTUNITY

The Card Ministry is a growing, vital outreach at Immanuel. The team is in need of a card design coordinator to provide creative input for the design of new cards.
